From the Superintendent

The golf season is approaching fast. Over the winter we freshened up paint on tee markers, ball washers, trash cans, and signs. All equipment was serviced and the reels and blades sharpened. Some dead trees have been removed as well as a few that affected the health of the turf.

You may notice the fairways and tees have a blueish green color to them. Round-up has been sprayed on the dormant Zoysia to help clean up the cool season grass and weeds that have popped up during the winter. This application is done to create a clean mono-stand of Zoysia. The color on the fairways is a dye used to see the areas that have been sprayed. The dye will soon fade out and the fairways will return to their natural color.

The golf course is back to normal play. We are back to one cup and the tee markers have been placed on their normal tees. Some changes have been made to a few of the gold tees to help with the health of some of the smaller tees. The reason for these changes are to lessen the traffic and stress of the small tees and to allow more options for tee placement.

The maintenance staff is excited to get back to working on the golf course and improving the playing conditions at Stagg Hill Golf Club. One major focus this year will be seeding weak areas around many tees, fairways, and greens. This will be a process that will take some time to see the benefits but will greatly improve playing conditions and the overall aesthetics of the course. We look forward to seeing you on the course.
